Use of cookies and tracking tools

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small data record that is stored on your end device and contains data such as personal page settings and login information. This data record is generated by the web server with which you have established a connection via your web browser and sent to you. In general, we use cookies to analyze interest in our websites and to improve the user-friendliness of our websites.

How we use cookies

Our websites use cookies to provide full functionality, to offer you a customized browsing experience and to enable us to optimize the performance of the website.

Types of cookies

We use the following cookies:

Necessary cookies

These cookies help you to use our website, for example by enabling basic functions such as page navigation and access to secure areas of the website or by saving the status of your cookie settings. Our website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Functional cookies

These types of cookies allow a website, for example, to remember choices you make or information you input (such as the region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal features. 
